- Applicants for all grants must be nonprofit organizations
- Grants are funded through the sale of state bonds and are available on a reimbursement basis
- All awards and funding are contingent upon approval by the Governor and Legislature
- Competitive grant process conducted every 2 years

Community Capital Facilities

Capital funds for Washington's community non-profit organizations as they expand their facilities.

Our three capital grant programs are:

- **Building for the Arts:** Matching grants pay up to 20 percent of eligible capital costs to non-profit arts and cultural organizations. Projects include theaters, galleries and other cultural-related space. The maximum grant award is \$2 million.
- **Building Communities Fund:** Matching grants pay up to 25 percent of eligible capital costs to non-profit social service organizations. Projects include non-residential community and social service centers. There is no minimum or maximum grant award amount.
- **Youth Recreational Facilities:** Matching grants pay up to 25 percent of eligible capital costs to community-based organizations that feature a major recreational component and an accompanying educational and/or social service component. The maximum grant award is \$1.2 million.
