Annual Traffic Safety Grants



We award federally-funded grants on an annual cycle for projects addressing behavioral change in one or more of the top Target Zero priorities.

Who is eligible to receive WTSC grants?

- Washington state agencies
- Federally recognized tribal governments
- Cities, counties and their sub-agencies
- Non-profit organizations with IRS 501©(3) status
- Public schools
- Private schools with non-profit status

State Grants



We provide state-funded grant opportunities for the purchase of:

- School zone flashing lights
- Crossing guard equipment and training
- School zone enforcement equipment.

Who qualifies?

- State, county, city and tribal law enforcement
- Public, private and tribal schools within the state

Private Grants



State Farm Teen Driver Grants are organized by the WTSC and paid for in the public interest by State Farm Insurance Companies. These grants fund teen alcohol and distracted driving projects for high schools.
