Dear Mayor Key:

Federal regulations require that a metropolitan planning organization (MPO) be designated for every urbanized area with a population over 50,000. The 2010 U.S. Census has identified the greater Walla Walla Valley area as an urbanized area, including the City of Milton-Freewater and a portion of Umatilla County in Oregon.

In response to your request, I am designating the Walla Walla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization as the metropolitan planning agency responsible for carrying out the provision of Federal regulations (29CFR part 450) for the urbanized area. The regulations require metropolitan planning organizations to conduct a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process.

I want to thank you and the Interim Lead Agency and Policy Board Members for all your hard work including working with key transportation entities and stakeholders in setting up your new, bi-state MPO. Your work is highly valued given that this new bi-state MPO will become the forum for making cooperative transportation decisions for your metropolitan planning area. I am also requesting that the Oregon Department of Transportation inform the U.S. Department of Transportation and the Federal Transit Administration of the designation.
